Word of Life Temple, Inc., stands as a beacon of faith, hope, and service in the heart of Raeford, North Carolina. Founded in 1988 by Bishop James O. Cunningham and his wife, Doris T. Cunningham, alongside their family and a devoted group of believers, this church has been a testament to God's provision and a center for spiritual and community growth.

CHARGE TO THE DEACONS | Elder Teresa McCrimmon
